Williams County Injury Crash

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: 104th Ave NW near 82nd Street NW (just north of McGregor, ND)

When: August 31, 2020 at approximately 2212hrs CST

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: 1 motorcycle

Type of Crash: 1 vehicle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williams County Sheriff's Department,

Tioga PD, Burke County Sheriff's Office, Tioga EMS and Fire, and Valley Med

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 Harley Davidson

Operator No. 1: Male, 46, Tioga, ND; minor injuries.

Restraints: no helmet

Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: Female, 29, Epping, ND; serious injuries.

Restraints: no helmet

NARRATIVE: The Harley Davidson was traveling southbound on 104th Ave NW towards McGregor, ND when a deer ran across the roadway. The operator of the motorcycle applied his brakes to avoid the deer. The motorcycle was laid down causing the operator and his passenger to be thrown from the motorcycle. The operator and passenger were transported to Tioga Medical Center to be treated for their injuries. However, the passenger was later flown to Sanford Medical in Fargo, ND due to potential serious injuries sustained in the crash. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
