I-94 Mandan, ND rollover Crash

What: Rollover Crash

Where: Interstate 94, mile marker 155 (eastbound) – Mandan, ND

When: 12/01/2020 at approximately 1600 hrs

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

NARRATIVE: The 2004 Pontiac Grand Am was traveling eastbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 155. A vehicle merged into the Pontiac's lane to avoid a third vehicle that had merged into their lane. The driver of the Pontiac drove to the left, lost control and rolled in the median. The driver and passenger of the Pontiac were transported by Ambulance to CHI – St Alexius' Hospital and assessed for non-life-threatening injuries.

The North Dakota Highway Patrol is requesting the public's assistance in identifying a white SUV (possibly a Nissan) that was in the area at the time of this crash. If you have any
