Two Vehicle Injury Crash

What: Two vehicle injury crash

Where: 318th Ave. and 66th St. (4 miles east of Wilton)

When: 12/16/2020 123 PM

Road Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Two vehicles

Type of Crash: Intersection related rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Burleigh County SO

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Chrysler Sedan Driver No. 1: Female (20), Wilton, ND - Injured Restraints: Unrestrained

Vehicle No. 2: 2008 Ford F350 Driver No. 2: Male (51), Wilton, ND - Injured Restraints: Unrestrained

NARRATIVE:

A 2015 Chrysler was traveling southbound on 66 St. NE. A 2018 Ford was traveling eastbound on 318th Ave. At the intersection of the two roadways the driver of the Chrysler failed to yield. The vehicles collided in the intersection. The Chrysler spun counterclockwise and came to rest on the north shoulder east of the intersection. The Ford spun clockwise entering the SE ditch. The Ford rolled one revolution and came to rest on its wheels facing SW in the bottom of the ditch. Both drivers were transported to Sanford in Bismarck by Wilton and Metro Ambulance. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
