Vehicle No. 2: 2020 Kia Optima

Driver No. 2: 34-year-old female from Fargo, Serious Life-Threatening Injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt on, airbag deployed

Charges: None

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1, driven by Deputy Zackary Moran of McKenzie County Sheriff Department, was traveling northbound on 12th St NE in Watford enroute to a Vehicle/Pedestrian fatality crash. Moran entered the intersection with 4th Ave NE with lights and sirens activated. Moran had a red light. Vehicle 2 was traveling eastbound on 4th Ave NE and entered the intersection with a green light. The McKenzie County Sheriff's squad car struck Vehicle 2 in the passenger side with its front. Vehicle 2 was pushed into northeast ditch causing it to roll once coming to rest upright. Female was transported to the hospital in



Watford City and then airlifted to Trinity Hospital in Minot for life threatening injuries. Crash is still under investigation by the Highway Patrol. Name of female driver will be released upon notification of family.
