## 2-vehicle injury crash - Interstate 94 – Sterling, ND

**NARRATIVE:** The Pontiac Bonneville, Ford Mustang and Isuzu Cube Truck were all traveling westbound on Interstate 94 near mile marker 183 (about 1 mile east of Sterling, ND). The Pontiac was in front of the Mustang which was in front of the Isuzu. The Pontiac and Ford slowed for a separate crash that had occurred in the area. The Isuzu rear-ended the Ford which spun towards the median. The Isuzu then rear-ended the Pontiac which spun into the left-hand lane. The Isuzu went into the north ditch and came to rest. The driver of the Ford and the occupants of the Isuzu were transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital. The passenger of the Ford was transported by Sanford Air Med to Sanford Hospital. The driver of the Pontiac sustained minor injuries.

Interstate 94 (eastbound) was closed for approximately 30 minutes as a result of this crash.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
