Mandan, ND Injury Crash

What: Injury Crash

Where: Main Street West - Mandan, ND

When: 11/26/2020 at approximately 9:06 am

Road Conditions: Icy Roadway

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Mandan PD, Metro Ambulance, Mandan Fire and Rescue

Vehicle No. 1: 1995 Chevrolet Silverado

Driver No. 1: Quentin Quam - 18 years old – Mandan, ND – not injured

Restraints: Seatbelt in use **Charges:** Under Investigation

Passenger No. 1: Evan Quam – 34 years old – Mandan, ND – non-life-threatening injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt not in use

NARRATIVE: The 1995 Chevrolet was traveling westbound on Main Street West near 14th Ave NW in Mandan, ND. The driver lost control of the pickup and struck a curb; causing the vehicle to overturn onto its passenger side. The driver was not injured. The passenger was transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck for non-life-threatening injuries.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
