## CMV Rollover and I-94 Closure

What: Commercial Motor Vehicle Property Crash

Where: I-94 MP 27, Medora exit.

When: 11/03/2020 0950 hours.

**Road Conditions:** Normal

Weather Conditions: Clear

**Type of Crash:** Single Vehicle Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Billings County Sheriff's Department, US Park Service, ND DOT.

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2020 Freightliner pulling a box trailer

**Driver No. 1:** Taieb Nassah, 51 years old, Indianapolis, IN, No Injuries

**Restraints:** Seat Belt **Charges:** None

Passenger No. 1: Mustapha Benayad, 53 years old, Indianapolis, IN, No Injuries

**Restraints:** None, In Sleeper Birth.

NARRATIVE: Taieb Nassah was traveling eastbound on I-94 en route to Wisconsin from Oregon. Nassah lost control of the combination on I-94 MP 27 and entered the south ditch. Nassah attempted to regain control but the trailer overturned and came to rest on the passenger side. The trailer was blocking both eastbound travel lanes. The occupants were not injured in the crash. East End Towing removed the semi and trailer from the scene. Eastbound I-94 was closed for approximately 7 hours while traffic was re-routed through Medora.
