NARRATIVE: The 2011 Chevrolet Silverado was eastbound on 52nd St SE about ½ mile west of Kindred, ND. The driver lost control of the vehicle and entered the north ditch where the vehicle rolled over. The vehicle came to rest upright in a sugar beet field. Both occupants were wearing their seatbelts. The driver was flown to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. The passenger was transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital. Both men suffered non life threatening injuries. The driver, Scott Heath, was charged with driving under the influence of alcohol (DUI).
