## **McKenzie County Injury Crash**

What: Injury Crash

Where: 23<sup>rd</sup> St NW and 125<sup>th</sup> Ave NW (Few miles south of Watford City)

When: September 17, 2020 at approximately 1654hrs CST

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Sunny

**Crash Involvement:** One SUV Crossover and One Pickup

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, McKenzie County Sheriff's Department,

and McKenzie County Fire and EMS

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2010 Ford Edge

**Driver No. 1:** Male, 54, Watford City, ND; injured. **Restraints:** Seat belt worn, Air Bags deployed

**Charges:** Under investigation

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2016 GMC Sierra

**Driver No. 2:** Female, 29, Watford City, ND; No apparent injuries.

**Restraints:** Seat belt worn, Air Bags deployed

**Charges:** Under investigation

**Passenger No. 1:** Juvenile male, 6, Watford City, ND; injured.

**Restraints:** child restraint utilized

**Passenger No. 2:** Juvenile male, 4, Watford City, ND; no apparent injuries.

**Restraints:** child restraint utilized

**Passenger No. 3:** Juvenile Female, 2, Watford City, ND; no apparent injuries.

**Restraints:** child restraint utilized



**NARRATIVE:** The Ford Edge was traveling eastbound on 23<sup>rd</sup> St NW as the GMC Sierra was traveling southbound on 125<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. The Ford Edge disregarded a stop sign at the intersection of 23<sup>rd</sup> St NW and 125<sup>th</sup> Ave NW striking the side of the GMC Sierra. Both vehicles entered the southeast ditch where they came to rest. The driver of the Ford Edge was transported to McKenzie County Healthcare Systems for injuries sustained in the crash. One of the juveniles (6) in the GMC Sierra was also transported to the McKenzie County Healthcare Systems for injuries sustained in the crash. The crash is still under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
