NARRATIVE: The truck was southbound, and the pickup was northbound on ND-22 when they collided head-on near mile marker 138. The northbound lane widened to have a passing lane at this location. The roadway curved to the right for northbound traffic. The pickup failed to negotiate the curve and crossed the passing lane and the double, solid yellow, center lines. The pickup struck the truck head on with the front, passenger side of both vehicles making initial contact. The driver of the pickup was airlifted to Sanford Hospital in Bismarck.
