25th St S & 13th Ave S Vehicle vs Pedestrian Injury Crash

What: Vehicle vs pedestrian injury crash

Where: Intersection of 25th St S and 13th Ave S in Fargo

When: December 13th, 2021 at approximately 6:45 pm

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, dark with street lights

Type of Crash: A vehicle struck a pedestrian

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo PD, Fargo FD, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2015 Chevrolet Impala

Driver No. 1: 18 YOA male, Fargo, ND – not injured

Restraints: Unknown at this time; no air bag deployment

Charges: None at this time; crash remains under investigation

Pedestrian: Unknown adult male; life threatening injuries, transported to Sanford

Hospital in Fargo by FM Ambulance

NARRATIVE:

On December 13th, the NDHP was requested by the Fargo Police Department to investigate a vehicle vs pedestrian crash that occurred at the intersection of 25th St S & 13th Ave S in Fargo. The crash occurred at approximately 6:45 pm.

A 2015 Chevrolet Impala, driven by an 18 YOA male from Fargo, ND, was southbound on 25th St S in lane 1. The Impala was traveling through the intersection of 13th Ave S on a green light.

On the south side of the intersection, the Impala struck a pedestrian crossing 25th St S in the crosswalk. The front of the Impala struck the pedestrian. After striking the pedestrian, the driver of the Impala stopped his vehicle on scene. The driver of the Impala has been cooperative throughout tonight's investigation.

The pedestrian is an unknown, adult male. Law enforcement is currently working on positive identification for the injured male. He was taken by FM Ambulance to Sanford Hospital with life threatening injuries.

Traffic was impacted on 13th Ave and 25th St for approximately two hours this evening while the on-scene investigation occurred.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol. We are being assisted by the Fargo Police Department.

Names of the parties involved will not be released until the evening on December 14th.
