25th St S & 13th Ave S Vehicle vs Pedestrian Injury Crash *Updated – Driver name release; public help requested*

What: Vehicle vs pedestrian injury crash

Where: Intersection of 25th St S and 13th Ave S in Fargo

When: December 13th, 2021 at approximately 6:45 pm

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Cloudy, dark with street lights

Type of Crash: A vehicle struck a pedestrian

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Fargo PD, Fargo FD, FM Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: Driver No. 1: Restraints:	2015 Chevrolet Impala <mark>Nataneil Solomon</mark> , 18 YOA male, Fargo, ND – not injured Unknown at this time; no air bag deployment
Charges:	None at this time; crash remains under investigation
Pedestrian:	Unknown adult male; life threatening injuries, transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo by FM Ambulance

NARRATIVE:

On December 13th, the NDHP was requested by the Fargo Police Department to investigate a vehicle vs pedestrian crash that occurred at the intersection of 25th St S & 13th Ave S in Fargo. The crash occurred at approximately 6:45 pm.



A 2015 Chevrolet Impala, driven by Solomon, was southbound on 25th St S in lane 1. The Impala was traveling through the intersection of 13th Ave S on a green light. This intersection is controlled by traffic lights for vehicle and pedestrian traffic. All were functioning at the time of the crash.

On the south side of the intersection, the Impala struck a pedestrian crossing 25th St S in the crosswalk. The pedestrian was crossing 25th St S from west to east. The front of the Impala struck the pedestrian. After striking the pedestrian, the driver of the Impala stopped his vehicle on scene. The driver of the Impala has been cooperative throughout the investigation.

The pedestrian is an unknown, adult male. Law enforcement continues to work on identifying the injured male. He was taken by FM Ambulance to Sanford Hospital with life threatening injuries. We are asking the public for their help in identifying the male. He is a 30-45 YOA white or possibly Native American male, with salt & pepper hair, with thinning hair and a receding hair line. He 5'-10" to 6'-2" and 200-240 lbs. The male had a distinctive scorpion tattoo on his left shoulder (see picture below).

If the public has any information to help the NDHP to identify the male, we request they contact ND State Radio at (701) 328-9921 and ask to speak to a Fargo area NDHP Trooper.

Traffic was impacted on 13th Ave and 25th St for approximately two hours this evening while the on-scene investigation occurred.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol. We are being assisted by the Fargo Police Department.
