## **Injury crash near Enderlin**

What: Injury crash

Where: Highway 46, mile marker 85 (east side of Enderlin)

When: June 30, 2021 @ 6:20 p.m.

Road Conditions: Good, dry

Weather Conditions: Sunny, calm

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs. Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Head-on

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Ransom County Sheriff, Enderlin Fire/First Responders, Sanford

AirMed, Lisbon Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2014 Chevrolet Impala

**Driver No. 1:** Jeanne Eskelson, 72; Enderlin, ND; non-life threatening injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt not in use

**Charges:** Failed to maintain control

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2014 Chevrolet Traverse

**Driver No. 2:** Brooke Sandvig, 42; Enderlin, ND; minor injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

Charges: None

**Passenger No. 1:** Tyler Pfaff, 43; Enderlin, ND; uninjured

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

Passenger No. 2: Juvenile male, 11; Enderlin, ND; minor injuries

**Restraints:** Child restraint in use

**NARRATIVE:** Vehicle 2 was eastbound on Highway 46 leaving Enderlin and Vehicle 1 was traveling westbound on Highway 46. The driver of Vehicle 1 reportedly fell asleep and



drifted over the center line. The driver of Vehicle 2 steered right to avoid a head-on collision. The front of Vehicle 1 truck the left rear corner of Vehicle 2. Vehicle 2 came to rest in the south ditch; Vehicle 1 continued through the Enderlin Veterinary Clinic parking lot before striking a dumpster and then into a group of trees. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
