I-29 Double Fatality Crash

What: Two vehicle crash, two fatalities

Where: I-29 MP 53, 7 miles south of Fargo.

When: Sunday, 09/26/2021, approximately 1:16 AM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear/normal

Crash Involvement: 2 vehicles

Type of Crash: Head on

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Cass County Sheriff's Department, Kindred

Ambulance, FM Ambulance, Horace Fire Department, Kindred Fire Department, Sanford

AirMed.

Vehicle No. 1: 2011 Chevrolet Silverado

Driver No. 1: male; age 65; of Moorhead, MN; fatality

Restraints: Seatbelt not worn; airbag deployed

Charges: None

Passenger No. 1: female; age 55, of Moorhead, MN; seriously injured

Restraints: Seatbelt not worn; airbags deployed

Vehicle No. 2: 2015 Ford Expedition

Driver No. 2: male; age 27; of Fargo, ND; fatality.

Restraints: Seatbelt worn; airbag deployed

Charges: none

Passenger No. 1: male; age 38, of Fargo, ND; seriously injured

Restraints: Seatbelt worn, airbags deployed



Passenger No. 2: male; age 32; of Fargo, ND; seriously injuried

Restraints: Not restrained, airbags deployed.

NARRATIVE: The Expedition was southbound on I-29 and the Silverado was northbound. This area is under road construction and I-29 was head-to-head traffic. The Silverado crossed the center and struck the Expedition head on. The Expedition was spun around and came to rest in the median and the Silverado coming to rest in the middle of the roadway. Both drivers were killed in the collision. The female passenger inside the Silverado was transported by ambulance to Essentia Health in Fargo. One passenger of the Expedition was taken by Sanford AirMed to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. The other Expedition passenger was taken by Ambulance to Essentia Health Both vehicles were totaled in the collision. I-29 was closed for several hours while the crash was investigated with traffic diverted to Cass County Road 81.

More information will be released the evening of 09/26/2021 pending family notification. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
