What: Injury

Where: ND Highway 18, approximately 2.5 miles west of Portland, ND

When: 04/11/2022 at approximately 2:15 AM

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Single-vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Driver No. 1: Skylar Robinson; male; age 30; of Mayville, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Seat belt not worn

Charges: DUI

Passenger No. 1: Ashley Feltus; female; age 31; of Mayville, ND; non-life-threatening

injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt in use

NARRATIVE: Robinson was driving the Camry east on ND Highway 18, navigating a right-hand curve. Robinson lost control, and the Camry entered the south ditch where it rolled. Robinson was not wearing a seat belt and was ejected. He sustained serious injuries and was airlifted to Sanford Hospital in Fargo, ND. Feltus was wearing a seat belt and sustained non-life-threatening injuries. She was transported by ambulance to Sanford Mayville Medical Center in Mayville, ND.
