Two Vehicle Head-On Crash

What: Two vehicle, head-on crash

Where: Hwy. 13 MM 374, Richland County, near Barney

When: August 27th, 2022 @ approximately 2:15 am

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather: Dark, not lighted

Type of Crash: Head-on crash

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Richland County SO, Barney FD, Wyndmere FD, Wyndmere Ambulance and Breck Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2009 Toyota Corolla

Driver No. 1: Washington Weanquoi, 47 YOA male, Fargo, ND - Deceased

Restraints: Seat belt worn, air bag deployed

Charges: None

Vehicle No. 2: 2011 Nissan Altima

Driver No. 2: Kash Cutler, 19 YOA male, Frederick, SD - serious injuries

Restraints: No seat belt worn, air bag deployed

Charges: Under investigation

Passenger No. 1: William Nordine, 19 YOA male, Aberdeen, SD - serious injuries

Restraints: No seat belt worn, air bag deployed



NARRATIVE:

On August 27th, at approximately 2:15 am, a two-vehicle head-on crash occurred on Hwy. 13 MM 374, just east of Barney, ND.

A 2009 Toyota Corolla was traveling eastbound on Hwy. 13 and a 2011 Nissan Altima was traveling westbound on Hwy. 13. Near MM 374 they collided head-on on the roadway.

After the collision, the Nissan came to rest on the westbound shoulder. The Nissan was facing west and was upright. The Toyota came to rest in the north ditch. The Toyota was facing southeast and was upright.

The driver of the Toyota, Washington Weanquoi, was pronounced dead on scene.

The driver and passenger in the Nissan, Kash Cutler and William Nordine, were both injured in the crash and were both transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo for serious injuries.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
