Williston Motorcycle Injury Crash

What: Injury

Where: Highway 1804 mm 316 (Just inside Williston city limits)

When: August 31, 2022, at approximately 0315 PM CST

Road Conditions: Good

Type of Crash: Roll over

Driver No. 1:	30 year old, male, Ranier MN – serious non-life threatening injuries

NARRATIVE:

Harley Davidson was travelling eastbound on Hwy 1804 near mile marker 316 (just inside city limits of Williston, ND). The driver lost control of the motorcycle, entered the south embankment, and rolled. The driver was ejected and suffered serious non-life threatening injuries. The driver was transported by Williston Ambulance to CHI St. Alexius Health in Williston.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
