## 1 Vehicle Rollover NW of Larimore

What: Injury Crash

Where: US 2 MM 325 10 Miles NW of Larimore

When: 1/11/2022 @ 1600 PM

Road Conditions: Icy, snow blown

Weather Conditions: Blowing snow/Icy

**Crash Involvement:** 1 Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rollover

Agencies Involved: Grand Forks SO, Larimore Ambulance Service, NDHP

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2008 Nissan Titan

**Driver No. 1:** Raeann Vivier, Female, 42 yo, Rolla, ND

**Restraints:** Seatbelt **Charges:** None

Passenger No. 1: 1 yo juvenile male, Rolla, ND

**Restraints:** Carseat

Passenger No. 2: Daniel Parisien, 24 yo male, Rolla, ND, none to minor injuries

**Restraints:** Seatbelt

Passenger No. 3: Kirsten Azure 24 yo female, Rolla ND, no injuries

**Restraints:** No seatbelt

**NARRATIVE:** Vivier was coming from Rolla heading to Grand Forks. Vivier was traveling approximately 65 mph in the passing lane, lost control of the vehicle, went through the median, and the vehicle rolled. No passengers of the vehicle were ejected. Vivier was transported by ambulance Altru to be treated for a head injury. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
