## **Fatal Commercial Truck Crash**

What: Fatal Crash

Where: Intersection

When: 1200 Noon Central

**Road Conditions:** Good, seasonal

**Weather Conditions:** Overcast, calm winds, no precipitation

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle/Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Front to side, right angle

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, McKenzie County Sheriff's Office,

Fairview MT Fire, Richland Co. MT Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** White 2014 Volvo Truck Tractor **Trailer:** 2012 Smith side dump, empty

**Driver No. 1:** Allen Ray Emly, 60 years old, Fairview, MT (**DECEASED**)

**Restraints:** Not in use

Charges: None

**Vehicle No. 2:** Red 2001 Freightliner Truck Tractor

Trailer: 2011 Galyean Tanker, loaded with 165 barrels of salt water, contained **Driver No. 2:** Shawn Mitchell Flowers, 50 years old, Washington, KS (**Not Injured**)

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Charges:** None

**NARRATIVE:** A two-vehicle truck versus truck crash occurred that involved a fatal injury at about noon on 1/14/2022, at the intersection of McKenzie County Rd. 16 and 154th Ave NW, about 6 miles north of Cartwright, in McKenzie County, North Dakota. A red 2001 Freightliner truck towing a tanker loaded with 165 barrels of salt water was traveling west on McKenzie County Road 16. A white 2014 Volvo truck towing an empty side-dump trailer was northbound on 154<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. The Volvo failed to stop at a stop sign, striking the left side of



the Freightliner. The driver of the Volvo, Allen Emly, was transported the hospital in Sidney, MT where he died of his injuries. The driver of the Freightliner was not injured.

No hazardous materials were released from original containment.

This crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
