30x30 Signing Event Scheduled for Feb. 10

NARRATIVE:

The North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) will be hosting a media event and signing a 30x30 initiative pledge on February 10, 2022, at 1:30pm in the Brynhild Haugland Room. Colonel Brandon Solberg and all NDHP women troopers will be in attendance and available for questions.

The 30x30 initiative is a coalition of police leaders, researchers, and professional organizations who have joined together to advance the representation and experiences of women in all ranks of policing across the United States. The goal is to increase the representation of women in policing to 30% by 2030 and to ensure police policies and culture intentionally support the success of qualified women officers throughout their career.

Colonel Solberg stated, "The NDHP is working diligently to recruit and increase the number of women to create a more diverse and inclusive agency, and this pledge will serve as a public notice of our intentions."
