**What:** Injury

**Where:** Near the intersection of 58<sup>th</sup> St W and 15<sup>th</sup> Ave W within Williston city limits.

**When:** July 1, 2022, at approximately 0855 PM CST

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Clear

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle vs Pedestrian

### **NARRATIVE:**

The Ford Pickup was traveling west on 58<sup>th</sup> St W. The passenger opened the door and fell from the vehicle. The driver of the pickup applied the brakes. The pickup struck the female with the rear passenger side tire. The female was taken by ambulance to CHI St. Alexius Health – Williston. The female was then airlifted to Trinity Health in Minot.
