## Updated Williams County Fatality Crash

What: Two vehicle Fatality crash

Where: Intersection of 60<sup>th</sup> St NW and 129<sup>th</sup> Ave NW (approximately 4 miles west of Epping,

ND)

When: July 19th, approximately 0505 PM CST

Road Conditions: Dry, Clear gravel roadway

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Two vehicle crash

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Williams County Sheriff's Office, Williston Fire Department and

Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2004 Peterbilt **Driver No. 1** Donnie Wurz, 43 year old male, Choteau, MT – uninjured **Restraints:** Seatbelt in Use

Vehicle No. 2: 2020 Ford F-350 Driver No. 2: Randall Moe, 66 year old male, Tioga, ND - Fatality Restraints: Seatbelt not in use

## **NARRATIVE:**

The Ford was traveling east on 60<sup>th</sup> St. NW. The Peterbilt was traveling south on 129<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. The Peterbilt failed to yield at the intersection and struck the Ford on the driver side area of the vehicle. The Peterbilt came to rest in the east ditch partially blocking 129<sup>th</sup> Ave NW. The Ford came to rest in the east field. The driver of the Ford was pronounced deceased at the scene.



The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
