UPDATE 2 Vehicle Injury Crash with Fire

Where: I-94 mm 351 EB lanes (area of University Drive)

Vehicle No. 1: 2008 Chevrolet Silverado

Driver No. 1: Reed Satrom, 71 years old, Detroit Lakes, MN serious injury

Passenger No. 1: Everett Northup, 53 years old, Detroit Lakes, MN serious injury

Vehicle No. 2: 2014 Kenworth truck tractor and trailer

Driver No. 2: Brant Jacobson, 45 years old, Harwood, ND not injured.

Restraints: Seatbelt **Charges:** None

NARRATIVE: The 2014 Kenworth truck tractor and trailer driven by Mr. Jacobson was eastbound on I-94 near University drive in the middle lane. Traffic ahead began to slow down due to road construction on the Minnesota side of the river and so did the 2014 Kenworth. The 2008 Chevrolet Silverado, driven by Mr. Satrom, was following directly behind and did not slowdown in time, rear ending the 2014 Kenworth truck and trailer. The 2008 Chevrolet

Silverado immediately started on fire. The Reed Satrom and Everett Northup were both transported to Sanford Hospital in Fargo with serious injuries.

Northup remains hospitalized with serious injuries. Satrom has been released.
