NARRATIVE: The Harley Davidson motorcycle was traveling northbound on Interstate 29 at a speed reported by witnesses of 65-70 mph. The motorcycle began to wobble and the rider laid the bike down. Smith sustained serious injuries and was transported by helicopter to a local hospital. Interstate 29 northbound was shut down for approximately an hour during this event.

This crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
