UPDATED McKenzie County Injury Crash

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: Highway 68 near mile marker 2 (Approximately 10 miles east of Sidney, MT)

When: March 12, 2022, at approximately 0702 AM CST

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: One vehicle

Agencies Involved: McKenzie County Sheriff's Office, Richland County Sheriff's Office (MT),

Richland County Fire and Ambulance (MT)

Vehicle No. 1: 2011 GMC Sierra

Driver No. 1: Charles Steed, 31 year old male, Colorado City, Arizona – Seriously injured

Restraints: Seatbelt not in use **Charges:** Pending Investigation

Passenger No. 1: Nathaniel Steed, 19 year old male, Colorado City, Arizona – nonlife threatening

injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt not in Use

NARRATIVE:

The 2011 GMC Sierra was traveling westbound on Hwy 68. The GMC left the roadway to the north, overcorrected, crossed both lanes of travel, entered the south ditch, and struck a stop sign. The GMC struck a fence. The GMC came to rest in the south ditch facing north on its wheels. The passenger was ejected. Both occupants were transported to Sidney Health Center in Sidney, MT.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
