## **Ransom County Injury Crash**

What: Injury Crash

Where: 7200 Block of 127<sup>th</sup> Ave SE, rural Lisbon (4 miles SE of Elliot or 6 miles SW of Lisbon)

When: May 18, 2022 @ 19:10 p.m., CT

Road Conditions: Good, gravel road w/ culvert washed out; closed by local authorities

Weather Conditions: Clear, windy

**Crash Involvement:** One vehicle crash

**Type of Crash:** Embankment - See narrative

Agencies Involved: Ransom County SO, Sargent County SO, Lisbon PD, Lisbon Ambulance,

Milnor Ambulance, Casselton Ambulance, Sanford Airmed, Lisbon Fire Dept

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2009 Ford Explorer

**Driver No. 1:** Wesley Alinder, 43 you male, Lisbon, ND; Serious injuries

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use **Charges:** Investigation pending

**Passenger No. 1:** Wesley Alinder, 18 you male, Lisbon, ND; Serious injuries

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use

Passenger No. 2: Juvenile female, 14 yoa; Serious injuries

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use

**Passenger No. 3:** Juvenile male, 14 yoa; Serious injuries

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use

**Passenger No. 4:** Juvenile male, 15 yoa; Serious injuries

**Restraints:** No seat belt in use



**NARRATIVE:** The Ford Explorer driven by Alinder was southbound on 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE in the 7200 block. At this location, 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE is closed due to a culvert washout caused by erosion. The Explorer entered the washout and the front of the vehicle struck the opposite embankment, coming to rest at impact. Occupants of the vehicle were not wearing seat belts and sustained serious, non-life threatening injuries. Sanford Airmed transported three of the patients, utilizing two helicopters and one fixed-wing aircraft.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
