## **McHenry County 2 Vehicle Injury Crash**

What: Injury Crash

Where: Junction of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. and 48<sup>th</sup> St. N – 1 mile north of Karlsruhe, ND

When: 5-27-22, 12:05 PM

**Road Conditions: Good** 

Weather Conditions: Clear and sunny

**Type of Crash:** Angle – 2 vehicle "t-bone"

Agencies Involved: NDHP, McHenry County S.O.

Vehicle No. 1: 2012 Ford Focus

**Driver No. 1:** Jorden Keller – Burlington, ND, 26-year-old male

**Restraints:** seatbelt in use

**Charges:** none

Vehicle No. 2: 2003 Dodge Ram pickup

Driver No. 2: Randy Merck – Karlsruhe, ND, 62-year-old male

Restraints: no seatbelt in use

**Charges:** failure to yield at intersection

**NARRATIVE:** Unit 1 was northbound on 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave N and approaching the intersection with 48<sup>th</sup> St N, en route from the Minot area to a residence in rural Karlsruhe. Unit 2 was eastbound on 48<sup>th</sup> St N and approaching the intersection with 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave N, enroute from his residence to another residence in rural Karlsruhe. Unit 2 failed to yield the right of way to unit 1 at the intersection marked with a yield sign and was struck in a T-bone style crash by unit 1. Driver 1 was properly restrained by seat belt and airbags deployed. Driver 2 was not restrained by seat belt and airbags deployed. Both drivers suffered apparent non-life-threatening injuries and were transported to Trinity Hospital – Minot by ground EMS. Driver 2 was cited for failing to yield the right-of-way at an intersection marked with a yield sign. Assisting agencies were the McHenry County Sheriff's Office, Velva Ambulance Service, Towner Ambulance Service, and Karlsruhe FD. The crash is still under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
