Wohlk and two juvenile passengers. The vehicle encountered a slow-moving row crop sprayer traveling the same direction. The vehicle drove into the right ditch as it approached the sprayer. The vehicle faulted off an approach and overturned end-over-end. The driver was partially ejected and was pronounced dead at the scene by the county coroner. The juveniles sustained injuries. One was transported to Trinity Hospital by ambulance, the other was transported by helicopter. Both injured juveniles have been treated and released from the hospital. This crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
