## Fargo serious injury crash – November 2 - Update

**What:** Serious injury crash

**Where:** 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue S/66<sup>th</sup> Street S, Fargo

When: Around 3:30 p.m. CT

**Road Conditions:** Good, dry concrete

Weather Conditions: Sunny, breezy

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle vs. Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Angle

**Agencies Involved:** Fargo PD, West Fargo PD, NDHP, FM Ambulance

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2008 Ford Edge

**Driver No. 1:** 15 YOA female; Fargo, ND; No injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Charges:** Pending investigation

**Passenger No. 1:** Juvenile female; No injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Passenger No. 2:** Juvenile female; No injuries

**Restraints:** Seat belt in use

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2012 Suzuki motorcycle

**Driver No. 2:** Jake Krumm, 18 YOA male; West Fargo, ND; Serious, life-

threatening injuries

**Restraints:** Helmet in use

**Charges:** Pending investigation

**NARRATIVE:** The motorcycle was traveling eastbound on 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue S while the SUV turning left to go from 66<sup>th</sup> Street S to go west on 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue S. The motorcycle



struck the front left corner of the SUV. Krumm was thrown from the vehicle and landed in the roadway. He was transported to a local hospital for serious, life-threatening injuries. The names of the juvenile driver and passengers will not be released.

The crash remains under investigation by the ND Highway Patrol.
