## NARRATIVE:

On November $7^{\text {th }}$, at approximately 2:26PM CDT, a pickup crossed the median of I-94 and struck a semi-tractor/trailer. The crash happened in the westbound lane of I-94 near mile marker 145, about 5 miles west of Mandan. An eastbound GMC Sierra pickup crossed the median and struck the near the rear tractor wheels of the oncoming semi that was traveling in the left westbound lane. The occupants of the pickup were ejected. The driver and passenger of the pickup were transported with serious injuries to Sanford by Metro Ambulance. The driver of the semi was not injured and was not transported.

Both westbound lanes of I-94 were blocked by the crash. I-94 traffic was rerouted at exit 147 to exit 140 for approximately $11 / 2$ hours.

The weather conditions at the time consisted of intermittent heavy snow. The roadway was slippery from melting and refreezing snow.

This crash is under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
