Nelson County - US Highway 2 and North Dakota Highway 1 Intersection Injury Crash

What: Injury crash

Where: North Dakota Highway 1, mile marker 295.5, on the east edge of Lakota

When: October 22nd at 5:50 PM CT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle/Vehicle

Type of Crash: Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Nelson County Sheriff's Office, Lakota Fire

Department, and Lakota Ambulance Service

Vehicle No. 1: 2009 Nissan Versa

Driver No. 1: Female; 34 years old; Lakota, ND, injured Unknown and passenger airbags deployed

Charges: Failed to yield right of way

Vehicle No. 2: 2006 Toyota 4Runner

Driver No. 2: Jedidiah Bullard; 43 years old; Minot, ND; uninjured

Restraints: Seatbelt worn and airbags deployed

Passenger: Juvenile male; uninjured

Restraints: Seatbelt worn

NARRATIVE: The Nissan was eastbound on US Highway 2, attempting to turn left, northbound on North Dakota Highway 1. The Toyota was westbound on US Highway 2. The driver of the Nissan failed to yield the right of way, entered the intersection, and the right side of the Nissan struck the front center of the Toyota. Both units came to rest on the north



shoulder of US Highway 2. The driver of the Nissan was transported to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks by Lakota Ambulance Service.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
