NARRATIVE: Christie was eastbound on US Highway 2 when he encountered and struck a cow on the roadway. The cow came to final rest in the median and suffered fatal injuries. Vehicle 1 came to final rest in the eastbound traffic lane adjacent to the south ditch. The occupants of the Ford Taurus were transported to CHI Saint Alexius Hospital in Devils Lake for non-life-threatening injuries sustained in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
