Cass County DUI Injury Crash

What: Off highway vehicle, rollover crash

Where: Cass County Highway 38, 1 mile north of State Highway 46

When: September 10th, 2022, at 7:47 PM.

Road Conditions: Normal

Weather Conditions: Normal

Crash Involvement: One vehicle

Type of Crash: Ran off roadway, overturn, driver ejection

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Cass County Sheriff's Department,

Casselton Fire Department, Lisbon Ambulance Services

Vehicle No. 1: 2017 Polaris Ranger 900XP

Driver No. 1: Bruce Albert Storhoff, 51-year-old male, Nome, ND, injured.

Restraints: Not used

Charges: DUI

NARRATIVE: The Polaris Ranger was southbound on Cass County Highway 38, approximately 1 mile north of State Highway 46. The Ranger drove from the west ditch onto Highway 38, then into the east ditch. The Ranger attempted to correct but overturned several times ejecting Storhoff from the Ranger. The vehicle came to rest in a field on the east side of Highway 38.

The Ranger sustained heavy damage because of the rollover crash. Storhoff was seriously injured and taken by Lisbon Ambulance to Sanford Hospital in Fargo. Storhoff was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. He remains in critical but stable condition at Sanford Hospital.



The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
