What: Pedestrian Fatality Crash

Where: 32nd Ave W near Bison Drive

When: 08/20/2023 at approximately 338 AM CST

Road Conditions: Good, Dry

Weather Conditions: Clear

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Pedestrian

Type of Crash: Pedestrian Crash

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williston Police Department, Williams County Sheriff Office, Williston Fire, and Williston EMS

NARRATIVE: At approximately 0338 am on 32nd Ave W and Bison Drive in Williston, ND a southbound Chevrolet Silverado on 32nd Ave W struck a pedestrian. The driver of the Chevrolet Silverado was wearing his seatbelt and sustained no injuries. The female pedestrian was pronounced deceased on scene.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
