Williston Fatality Crash

What: Fatality

Where: Highway 2 near mile marker 18 – within the city limits of Williston, ND

When: September 4, 2023, approximately occurred sometime after 0900 PM CST

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Hazy, Dark - lighted

Crash Involvement: One vehicle rollover

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Williston Police Department, Williston Fire and Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2014 GMC Sierra

Driver No. 1: 33 year old male, Stillwater, OK – fatality

Restraints: seatbelt not in use

Passenger No. 1: 34 year old male, Stillwater, OK – fatality

Restraints: seatbelt not in use

NARRATIVE:

The GMC was traveling eastbound on Highway 2. The GMC failed to negotiate the curve in the roadway. The GMC left the roadway, struck the east guardrail, and vaulted off the embankment. The vehicle rolled and came to rest. Both occupants were ejected from the vehicle. They were pronounced deceased on scene. It is believed the crash occurred sometime last night after 0900 PM but was discovered this morning at approximately 1000 AM CST.

Names will be released pending the notification of next of kin.

The crash remains under investigation of the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
