Stutsman County DUI Crash

What: DUI Injury crash
Where: 7500 Block County Road 38, 10 miles southwest of Jamestown, ND
When: April 13, 2024 at around 10:47 p.m. CT
Road Conditions: Good, dry
Weather Conditions: None
Crash Involvement: Single vehicle
Type of Crash: Rollover
Agencies Involved: NDHP, Stutsman County SO, Jamestown Ambulance
Vehicle No. 1: 2008 Ford Fusion
Driver No. 1: Keira Weber, 18 YOF, Jamestown, ND; Serious injuries
Restraints: Seat belt not in use
Charges: DUI, open container of alcohol

NARRATIVE: At approximately 10:47 p.m., Vehicle 1 was traveling eastbound on County Road 38 southwest of Jamestown. Vehicle 1 lost control on the gravel road, ran off the roadway to the right, and entered the south ditch. Upon entering the south ditch, Vehicle 1 overturned, coming to rest on its roof. The driver was not wearing a seat belt, but was not ejected. The driver was transported to Jamestown Regional Medical Center and then Sanford Hospital in Fargo due to serious injuries sustained in the crash. The driver was charged with driving under the influence of alcohol, a Class B misdemeanor. She was also issued a citation for having an open alcohol container in the vehicle.
